

1789 Queens Head, Barns Green




I just caught something on the radio about Armstrong being stripped of his titles. So is he not the first man on the moon anymore?




BRIGHTON CAB DRIVER ... (retold from #164)

She stood before me, trembling in my shed. "I'm yours for the night," she gasped, "You can do whatever you want with me." So I took her to McDonalds.


She knelt before me on the shed floor and tugged gently at first, then harder until finally it came. I moaned with pleasure. Now for the other boot.
